Jims Tip: More on bowling shoes. I feel that the socalled "senior socks" are way overused. Red felt heels too. These are great innovations in the last 20 years that allow a good slide on tacky approaches. However, if the approaches aren't tacky, they often cause you to slide too far. With rare exceptions, your foot should be stopped when the ball passes your ankle. If it is still sliding, you have to use more muscle to get the same rev rate. It also can lead to you sliding with your body weight on your heel, instead of on your instep. This leads to loss of leverage and loss of ball speed. When you get it in your muscle memory, it's harder to correct.
