Jims Tips: On flatter patterns than a normal house shot, spares are a premium. They are also more difficult if you try to use your normal moves. For example, if you normally move 5-6 right for a 2 pin (righthanders), this may not work on a flatter pattern. At Hog Pin, I saw 12-15 2 pins missed....equally to the right and left. If you don't throw it straight at your spares, then you need an additional set of adjustments for flatter patterns.
