Mike Allison Wire to Wire in Debut!

A 988 block Sunday morning gave him a 116 pin lead starting the finals. Only Marshall Kulow could stay within contact in the finals and entering the title match, Kulow trailed by 99. He had to win by 70. Mike started /// and Marshall XXX. Allison left a 6-7-10 split in the 4th and his lead started to look a little shaky. However, he made a perfect shot and

converted the split, then reeled off a 5-bagger to stay close enough to Marshall and win the title in his first SASBA tournament.

Kulow got 2nd, Jimmy Fowler grabbed 3rd place, Mike McHugh got 4th and Willie Wells rounded out the top five.

Thanks to Chris Skilings and staff for hosting. The Fire Lake Grand Casino added \$2750 additional dollars to the prize fund to enable us to post a really beefy prize list.

Allison had the only 300. Besides Michael, Mark Payne and Tony Faustner also made

their first finals and Dale Painter got his first check.

Our next tournament is a SS Singles in Denton. It is full with a waiting list, but the following week, we'll be at Brunswick Westcreek in Fort Worth for a regular singles. Plenty of spots open there. Two weeks following Westcreek is the Recruiter Doubles at Cityview in Fort Worth. For that one, each member has to have a partner over 45 yrs. old. If over 50, they can never have bowled a SASBA event.

There wasn't enough hold though, if you tried to go straight up the boards...unless you used a weak solid or pearl cover with a control layout. The guys who repeated shots (target, speed,

release, and trajectory) the best made the finals. My tip is that no matter what pattern they put out, or how you try to match up, you still have to repeat. Fire Lake illustrated this!
