CHURCHEY WINS THIRD TITLE

Turnout for the first tournament of the year looked rather dismal on Monday, January 21 with the count at only 30 bowlers. By Friday the count was much improved but the weather had turned against us. The dedicated bowlers slid in, literally and we ended up with 55 bowlers.

Conditions were challenging and scores reflected the more demanding conditions.

Shannon Starnes led Saturday qualifying averaging 244 for the eight games. He outdistanced the 2nd place qualifier, Doug Hayes, by 128 pins.

Tony came out of the blocks blazing on Sunday morning shooting games of 297, 286, 226, and 246. He took over the top qualifying position going into match play. Tony continued to maintain the number 1 position throughout Sunday. Doug whittled the lead down to 36 pins going into the position round. Tony won the match 224 to 215 to claim his third SASBA title

Due to the field size we took 16 players to match play on Sunday. The cut to match play was +45. Ed Campbell and DL Moody received the

17th and 18th place checks. We had four Super Seniors checks on Sunday. These went to Dave Hartung, Troy Nixon, Grady Creasie and Ben Edwards. Dean Brimingham had high Sunday Black with 826.

The Memphis area had some slippery road conditions throughout the weekend, these matched up well with the pins "sliding" across the pin decks. New member Patrick Murphy from across the Mississippi in nearby Arkansas was delayed by standstill traffic on the "Bridge". Eddie Russell was back bowling after a recent health scare, he roped in lowed game of the weekend with 114.

The next tournament is scheduled for February 8 and 9 in Clarksville, TN at the Pinnacle Family Entertainment Center. We hope to have a good crowd because we plan on having a good time, with lots of high scores..

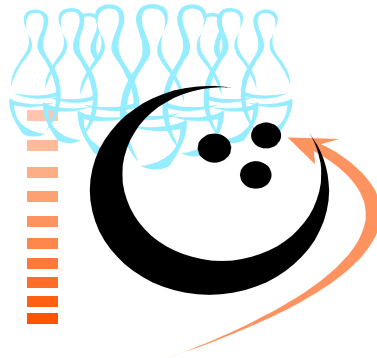
"HEAR THOSE PINS"
