Receiving the alternates check for 13th place were Ben Edwards and Bo Edwards missing match play finals by one pin.

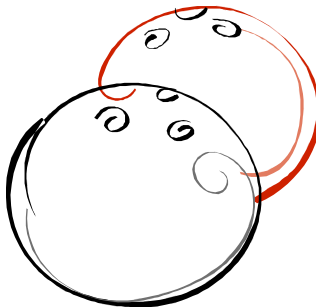
