Individually, John Montgomery-SS outscored all the other seniors on Saturday with a great 1848 / 231 average.

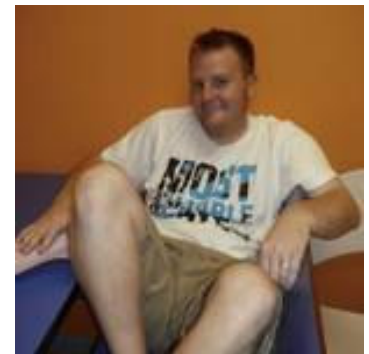
David and Jennifer Channell always make the bowlers feel welcome and we look forward to returning next year.

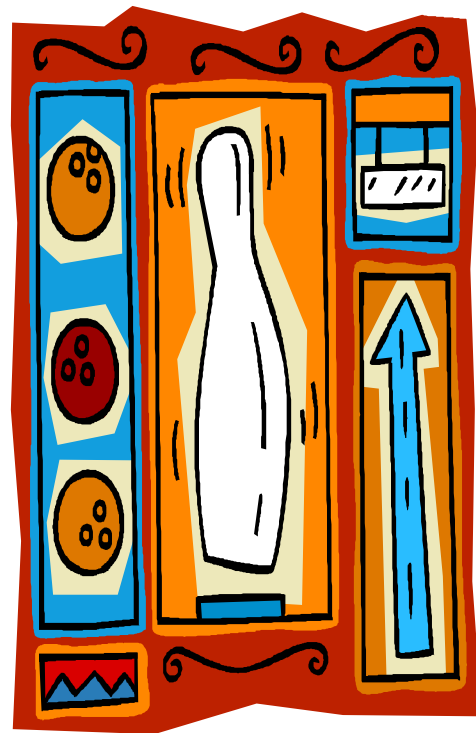

HISTORY LESSON 101

Savannah TN is named for Savannah GA. It is also the County Seat for Hardin County.

The Civil War Battle of Shiloh occurred in Hardin County, a few miles southwest of Savannah, near an area called Pittsburg Landing on the Tennessee River.

Savannah is also home to the Tennessee River Museum. The museum ex-

hibits chronicle prehistoric times, life of the Mississippian mound builders, the tragic story of the "Trail of Tears", the Civil War on the river, the Golden Age of Steamboats and the Tennessee River today.

The 2007 Census listed the population estimate at 7267. City officials strive to balance Savannah's rich 19th century heritage and liberal doses of "southern" hospitality with progressive ideas for the future.
