Delilah learned that Sam Sands and Doug Hayes have something in common, the name “Paul”.

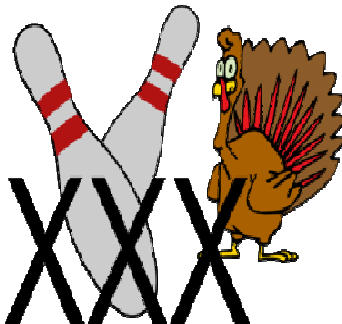
