When: December 4-5-6, 2009

Schedule of events:

Friday: Sweepers...starting at noon...2 games (4 age groups) cash 1 in 4 within each age group.

Saturday: Meeting at 8am. One 8-game qualifying block by age group...starting at 8:45

Sunday: Match play bracket finals by age group (2 games/total pins)...starting at 8:15

When 1 survivor remains in each age group, those 4 bowlers will bowl 1 game for title (\$1000 prize guaranteed for 4th place)

Entry fee: \$230

1 in 3 (up to 16) will make the finals in each age group. 1 in 3 will cash in each division. All rounds will be a blind draw for byes and opponents.

If there is a tie for the last finals spot within an age group, a 1 game rolloff will immediately follow the qualifying.

Age groups (as of Dec.5) will be as follows:

Legends bracket 50-56 yrs.

Old Timers bracket 57-62 yrs.

Codgers bracket 63-69 yrs.

Geezers bracket 70 and over
