I feel it's always best to expect the unexpected, then be pleasantly surprised when it isn't. Carry enough balls with different reactions that you are covered...no matter what you run into. "It is what it is" is a better

mindset to have. That way, you can adjust to whatever you see and preconceived ideas don't get in your way.
