Jack struck in the 9th and 10th and one more would force Pete to double. Another stone 9 meant Pete only had to mark with a good count. A single pin stopped Mark and Rick edged Joe 236-234. Pete got up and doubled for 257 to

end the suspense and had his 3rd SASBA title. Mark got 3rd, Rick was 4th and Joe held on to 5th place.

Thanks to Mike Holland for being a gracious host. The shot was very high scoring and fair left and right.
