Some new rules in 2005 will include a nonmembers entry fee of \$175 for regular singles tournaments. We hope this will encourage reluctant bowlers to try SASBA once or twice and not be scared off by the membership fee. If a non-member wins a tournament, they will not receive a jacket or a banner. However, the doubles, foursomes, team, annual championship and any tournament with more than \$2000 added are still for members only. Also, the member/guest doubles and foursome tournaments will have a \$175 entry fee for everyone. Hopefully, this will enable us to pay at least \$1000

for all 1st place finishes. In the meeting Saturday, the members decided to leave the tiebreaker procedure and scuff pad rules as they were for the upcoming season

Our next tournament is in Union City, TN on New Year's Weekend. There will be 8 games of qualifying on Saturday and single game /single elimination match play on Sunday.
