Jim struck out for 228, creating a scenario where he could not beat Sam, but had the lead on Ozio. David was forced to get X 9/ for a tie of the game and to win the title. Two strikes would clinch it for sure. Dave flushed the first one, but left the 4-7 in the 11th, thus losing to Jim by 1 pin (227-228) and making Sam the champion. Whew! What a finish.
